MINUTES OF REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING  
NOVEMBER 16, 2009**

Meeting called to order at 7:45PM. Members present: Sinclair, Kelsey, Nebor, Burdick.

Minutes of October 19, 2009 Regular Monthly meeting read by Nebor. Motion to approve with changes (Barnes Road Inquiry "an additional" town culvert and Ken Metzler, DEP "Botanist") made by Kelsey, seconded by Burdick, passed unanimously.

Old Business:

McDonald, 141 Belden Street Follow-up: Sinclair reported that there was no information attached to the routing sheet, therefore, he did not sign off.

Sturdevant, Arnott Drive Follow-up: Sinclair read two correspondences pertaining to the proposed project: 1) US Army Corps of Engineers Public Notice dated Nov. 3, 2009; 2) State of CT DEP to Allied Engineering Assoc. dated Oct. 30, 2009. Commission members agreed that Sinclair should send Commission's comments to US Army Corps of Engineers.

Citgo Gas Station: Sinclair reported that contaminated soil and water will be removed off site. This project is the continuation of the new tank installation.

Point of Rocks Endangered Species Follow-up: Dr. Wagner spoke to Sinclair about the importance of having a meeting to educate citizens as to the significance of the site. Commission members discussed possible dates and locations. December 2nd from 3-5PM at the HVRHS lecture hall was considered.

Regulations Update: Nothing to report

Cobble Hill AT&T Tower Proposal Follow-up: Sinclair told the Commission that we are now within the 60 day comment period before the application is submitted to the Siting Council. Commission members discussed the importance of the Town holding an informational meeting to allow the citizens to learn about the proposal and ask questions. Members agreed that an announcement from both IW/Conservation Commission and the Planning and Zoning Commission would be appropriate. Sinclair will follow-up with First Selectman to determine a date for the meeting.
